Competition Classes for Sprint & Middle Distance Events

| <u>Classes</u> | <u>Age of Competitor</u> |
|-----------------------|---|
| W14 M14 | up to 14 years old, born in 2001 or later |
| W16 M16 | up to 16 years old, born in 1999 or later |
| W18 M18 | up to 18 years old, born in 1997 or later |
| W20 M20 | up to 20 years old, born in 1995 or later |

Competition Classes for Sprint Relay Event

| <u>Classes</u> | <u>Age & of Competitor & Team Combination</u> |
|-----------------------|--|
| Youth | up to 16 years old, born in 1999 or later, 4 legs per team with at least 2 female runners |
| Junior | up to 20 years old, born in 1995 or later 4 legs per team with at least 2 female runners |

- 1. Minimum age of participation is age 13, born in or before 2002.*
- 2. In each individual class, each country may enter a maximum of 10 competitors .*
- 3. In each relay class, each country may enter 5 teams in each class but only the better-placed team will be counted in the prize list.*
- 4. Competitors representing member Federations of the IOF, defined by the International Olympic Committee as belonging to the Asian continent, can compete in AsJYOC.*

5. Competitors representing other member Federations of IOF or other Asian countries can participate in AsJYOC but will not be eligible for the AsJYOC titles, medals or diplomas.
6. The winners of the age class 20 and the age class 16 will be the Asian Junior Champions and the Asian Youth Champions of the AsJYOC respectively.

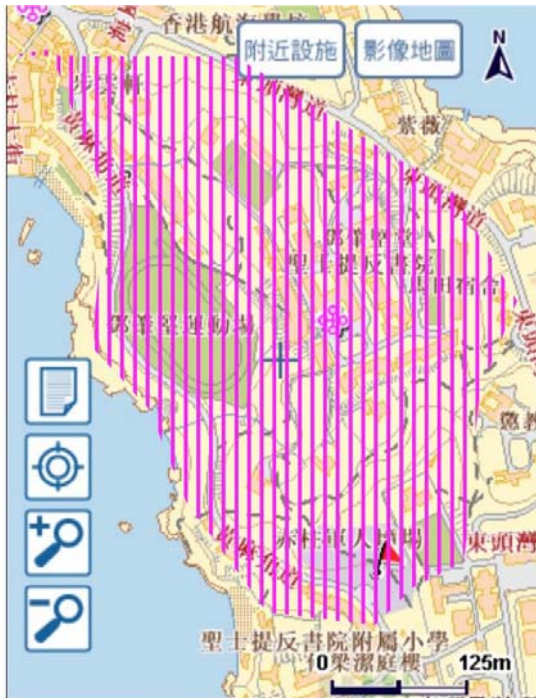
